


"A VIP Pilgrimage ← to THE most Hallowed grounds of Cycling" Step into the (cycling) shoes of the world's most famous cycling

BRIAN COOKSON OBE

Former President UCI

Your official host for this unique one-in-a-lifetime journey will be former UCI President Brian Cookson OBE. Brian will accompany you throughout the week and will ride alongside you and the legends, ensuring an unforgettable experience.

Born through his passion for cycling, Brian became involved in the organising, managing and governing of the sport, on a voluntary basis. In 1996, he led a new Board which transformed a failing organisation, the British Cycling Federation, which was in meltdown, close to bankruptcy, and had won one Olympic Gold Medal in 76 years, into an all-conquering national governing body, British Cycling.

By the time of the 2012 London Olympics, the sport and UK was back to its former glory; winning numerous Olympic and Paralympic medals and turning the sport into one of the most popular in Great Britain for men and women alike.

Brian was awarded the OBE for services to cycling in the New Year's Honours of 1 January 2008.

In 2013, with the cycling world shocked by the Lance Armstrong scandal, he challenged the incumbent President of the international federation, the UCI, winning the decisive vote at the Congress in Florence that September – the first time in some forty years that any standing President of any international sports federation had been defeated by a challenger.

As President of the UCI he set about rebuilding the image of the sport and established an international commission to investigate and analyse the reasons why the crisis had arisen, and to make recommendations as to how such problems could be avoided in the future. Having implemented these recommendations, established a new Ethics Commission, and made huge progress in improving neglected issues such as women's cycling, the opportunities for developing nations, and the role of non-competitive cycling in improving health, environment and pollution issues all around the world.

Brian concluded his mission in 2017 and retired back to Lancashire, where he now lives and cycles, and still involves himself in organising cycling events, such as the recent Lancaster Grand Prix. He is an Honorary Fellow of the University of Central Lancashire (2009), an Honorary MBA of the European University (2014), and an Honorary DBA of Manchester Metropolitan University (2015).



WINNER OF THE TOUR OF FLANDERS 1999, 2003, PARIS-ROUBAIX 2003

Peter is a former professional road racing cyclist born in Opbrakel, and is regarded as the specialist in single-day spring classics. In 1999 and 2003, 'de Zwarte van Brakel' won the Tour of Flanders.

He also won the Paris-Roubaix in 2003, matching Roger De Vlaeminck, who was the first of ten riders to win both cobblestones classics (the Tour and Paris-Roubaix) in 1977.

Van Petegem last rode for Quick Step-Innergetic, in 2007. He lived in Horebeke.

His legacy event The Peter Van Petegem Classic draws thousands of cycling fans every year.

WINNER PARIS-ROUBAIX 1999 TOUR OF FLANDERS 2002

Andrea specialized in the cobbled Spring Classics such as Paris-Roubaix which he won in 1999, and Tour of Flanders which he won in 2002.

He also won the Giro di Lombardia in 1996 and the Italian National Championship in 1998.

Recently celebrating 20 years of his Paris-Roubaix win, Andrea nearly returned to racing again in 2018-19.

Known as The Gladiator, Andrea finally put down his sword and shield to run an eponymous boutique II Borghetto, situated amongst the Tuscan olive groves and cypress trees, where each apartment is named after his big race wins.

BELGIAN CHAMPION 1999, AND TOUR DE FRANCE STAGE WINNER 1999


Born in Flanders, Ludo is a former Belgian racing cyclist.

In 1997, he scored his first victories in the Grand Prix Denain, Zellik-Galmaarden, and Hasselt-Spa-Hasselt, also finishing second in the Belgian championship that year

He is best known for his biggest wins in the 11th stage of the Tour de France, while competing for Lampre–Daikin, and the Belgian National Road Race Championships, both in 1999.

After a crash in Paris-Roubaix 2005, Ludo damaged the ligaments in his right hip, but decided to recover and race the latter half of the season before retiring with his last race in Tessenderlo in front of a huge and adoring crowd.
